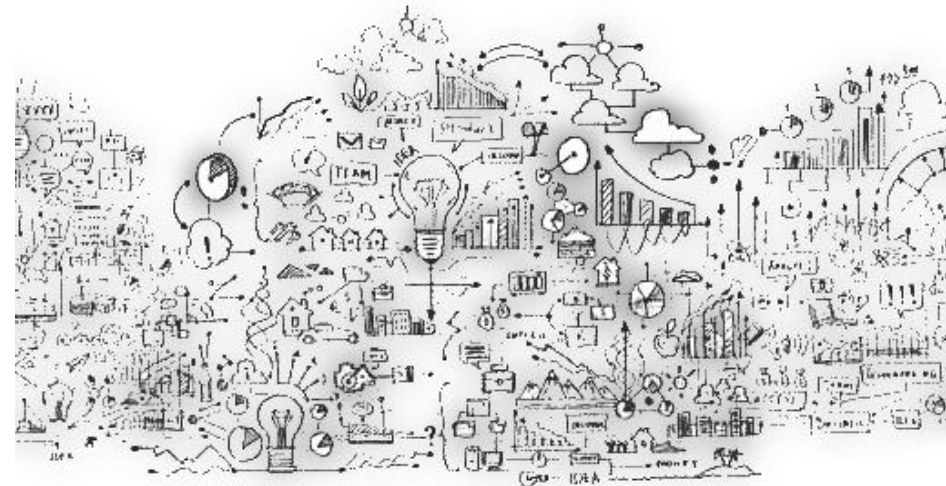

Responding to this challenge, research and innovation (R&I) under Horizon 2020 is an investment in better health for all. During the first four years of Horizon 2020 (Work Programmes for 2014/15 and 2016/2017), the EU will invest more than €2 billion in this Challenge; in calls for proposals or actions.

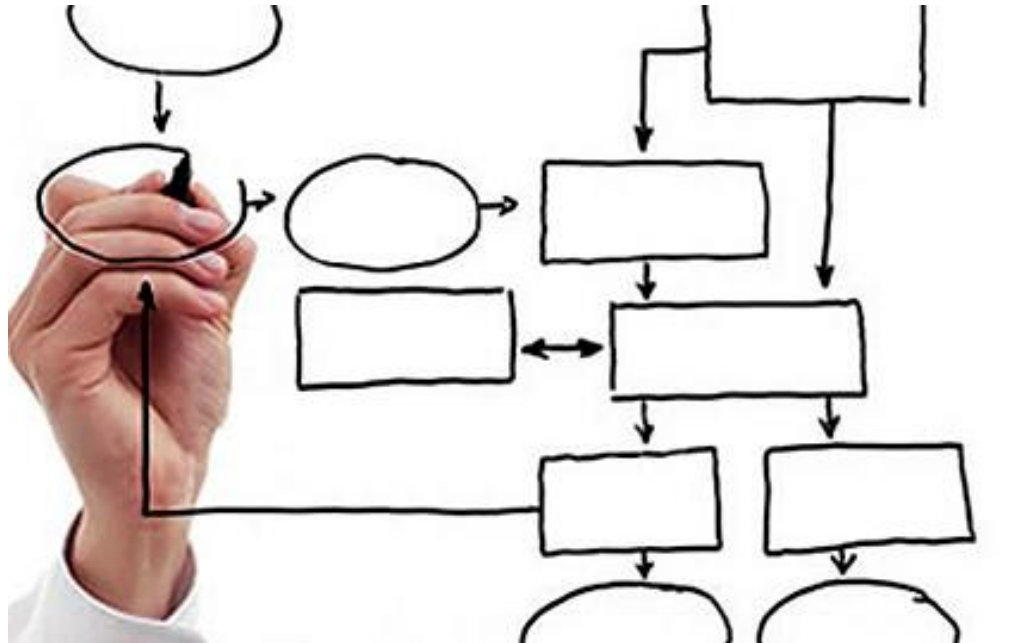

1- Excellence (science)

- Objectives
- Relation to the work programme
- Concept and approach: TRL! trans-disciplinary approach, methodology...
- Ambition: ground-breaking nature of the objectives, concepts involved, issues and problems to be addressed beyond state-of-the-art = innovation potential!)

2- Impact

Expected impact on:

- impact indication in the work programme
- enabling and improving innovation capacities (new knowledge, knowledge transfer, evidence based policy making, policy innovations) **EU-level!!!**
- barriers/obstacles/assumptions/risks (impact level, not project level)

3- Quality and Efficiency of the Implementation

- Work plan — Work packages, deliverables and milestones
- WP-objectives, timeline, description, deliverables, partners and risk analyses (including mitigation measures)
- Management structure
- Consortium description (multi-sector, geographical)
- Resources needed (direct and indirect)

Members of the Consortium



- Description of partners (profile, tasks, why they are the match?)
- Curriculum vitae of lead persons (gender!)
- Description of publications, services, products, achievements and projects relevant for the project (background, qualification, credibility)
- Available infrastructure
- Third parties involvement (subcontracting? affiliated entities?)
